

Technical Requirements

1. Provide a copy of these technical requirements to your school's technology support staff.
2. Each computer, laptop or tablet needs to have:
 - Windows 7 or newer, Macintosh OSX or newer, Chrome OS, or iOS operating system
 - If using an iPad, use iPad version 3 or newer
 - A display capable of rendering resolutions of 1024x768 pixels
 - External speakers or headphones
 - Broadband Internet Connection – Cable, DSL, LAN
 - One of the following web browsers, with JavaScript enabled and pop-up blockers disabled:
 - Google Chrome (recommended)
 - Firefox
 - Safari
 - Adobe Acrobat Reader 9.0 or later
3. Check that your technology support staff has given the computers permission to visit the following web domains:

4. Make sure you can receive emails from elearning@childrenswi.org and healthykids@childrenswi.org.
5. Check that your technology support staff has allowed permission to read XML (.xml), JSON (.json), MP3 (.mp3), M4A (.m4a), OGG (.ogg), and JavaScript (.js) files on all devices being used for this program.
6. As this program is equipped with a large amount of audio, headphones are very important for each student. We strongly recommend that, if your school does not already have headphones, you purchase them before your session or have the students bring their own.
7. Consider asking your school district to allow your computer lab more bandwidth. School labs typically are allowed about 1200 KBps of bandwidth. Nevertheless, your lab shares bandwidth with the entire school and may experience gaps due to use elsewhere in the school. You may wish to consult with your technology support staff on this issue.
8. Adobe Reader is the application students should be using to open PDFs. Version 9.0 or later is required. If your school does not have Reader on its computers, visit <http://www.adobe.com/products/reader/> to download the latest version. Please read through the specifications thoroughly to make sure Reader is compatible with your system.
